ISO 22000 is one of a family of standards focused on the development, implementation and improvement of a food safety management system for any organization in the food chain. As a generic food safety management standard, it can be used by any organization directly or indirectly involved in the food chain.

Organizations who can benefit are farms, fisheries and dairies, and the processors of meats, fish and feed, including the manufacturers of soups, snacks, bread, cereal, beverages and canned and frozen food. In addition, food service providers, such as restaurants, fast food chains, caterers, hospitals and hotels, as well as supporting services such as transportation and distribution providers can benefit from the implementation of an ISO 22000 system.

In short, if your products touch any part of the food industry, from the farm to the fork, part or all of the ISO 22000 requirements will apply.
